

PASSAGE

1 Kings 13:1-21

LEARN IT

We need to know what God says in order to know the truth. 2 Timothy 3 tells us that the Bible is inspired by God. That means that every word in your Bible was chosen by God.

LINK IT

In order to discover what is true, we've got to find the facts. If we are Christians, we find our facts in the Bible. Since God inspired the Bible, we can choose to trust it over what anyone else says.

COMPASS POINT

"Check it twice before taking some advice."

LIVE IT

It can be easy to let others tell us what is right, but in the end, if it doesn't match up to the Bible, it shouldn't be trusted.

MEMORY MAX
