LEARN IT

LINK IT

God created us with a lot of different emotions and he knows and understands when we hurt. It's okay to tell God how we feel, even when we are feeling angry or sad.

COMPASS POINT

"Sharing what's inside helps sadness subside."

LIVE IT

When we are sad about a loss, God is there, and he's listening. God is a good friend when we need comfort.

MEMORY MAX

"Why am I discouraged? Why so sad? I will put my hope in God!"  
Psalm 43:5a

# DEEP Q-CARD
